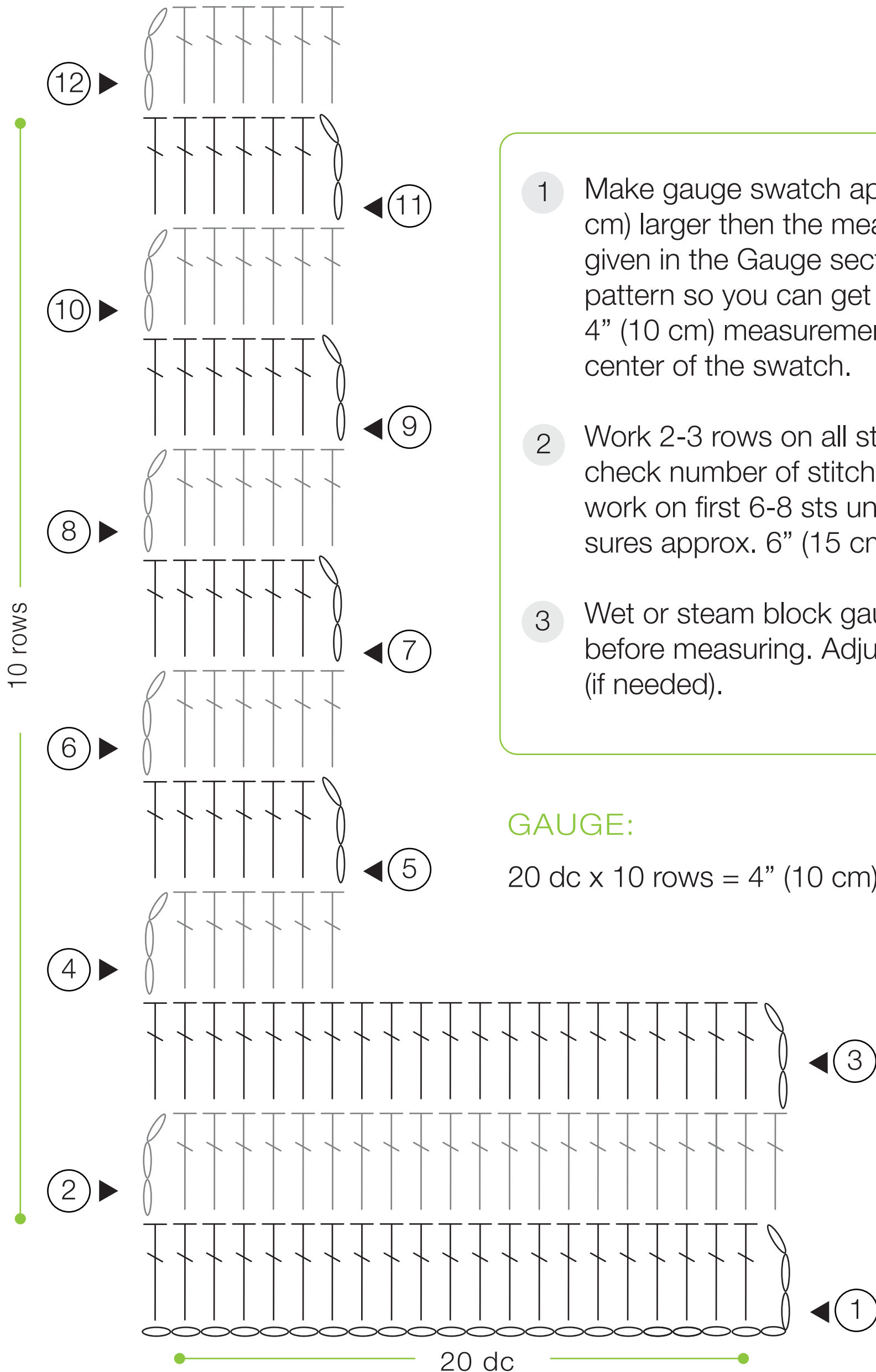


Gauge Swatch

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- 1 Make gauge swatch approx. 2" (5 cm) larger than the measurement given in the Gauge section of the pattern so you can get an accurate 4" (10 cm) measurement across the center of the swatch.
- 2 Work 2-3 rows on all stitches to check number of stitches. Continue work on first 6-8 sts until piece measures approx. 6" (15 cm).
- 3 Wet or steam block gauge swatch before measuring. Adjust the gauge (if needed).

GAUGE:

20 dc x 10 rows = 4" (10 cm) after blocking.
