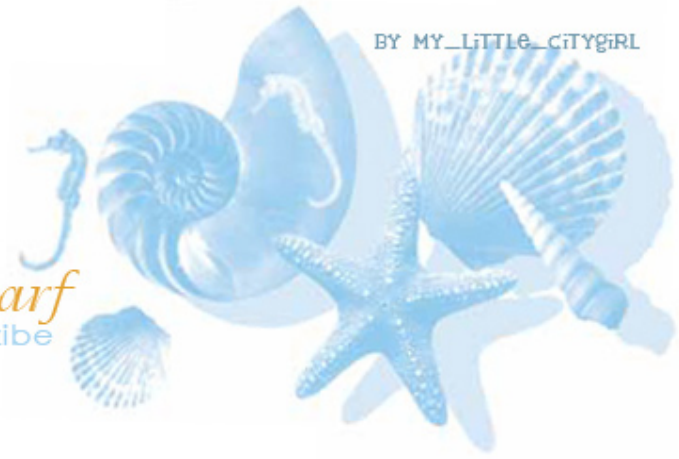

So fresh and breezy! This scarf can be made from any worsted plain or textured yarn. Such a fun project, which takes just a couple of hours. A Perfect gift idea too!

#### SKILL LEVEL

beginner

#### FINISHED SIZE

5" wide (in the widest part) by 46" long.

#### MATERIALS

- MC: Lana Grossa Stella 70% Cotton, 30% Polyamide (1.75 oz/ 88 m/ 50 g) in aqua/blues or any other worsted weight plain or textured yarn 2 balls
- CA: a small amount of white worsted weight yarn

#### CROCHET HOOK

F-5/3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>MM crochet hook

#### GAUGE

is not critical for this project.

## SCARF

**NOTE :** A scarf is worked as one piece. See diagram on the right.

- With MC, ch 18. Join with sl st in the 1<sup>st</sup> ch to form a ring and work in rounds.

**Rnd 1(RS):** ch 3 (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> dc now and throughout), 33 dc in ring; join with sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 3 = 34 dc.

**Rnd 2:** ch 4, [dc in next dc, ch 1] 33 times; join with sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 4 = 34 dc and 34 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 3:** ch 13, sk 4 ch-1 sps, [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 4] 30 times; join with sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 14, turn = 30 sc, 30 ch-4 sps and one ch-10 sp.

- Cont work in rows.

**Row 1:** ch 3, 17 dc in ch-10 sp, turn = 18 dc.

**Row 2:** ch 4, [dc in next dc, ch 1] 17 times; join with sl st in 4<sup>th</sup> ch-4 sp, started from ch-10 sp of previous motif, turn = 18 dc and 17 ch-1 sps.

**Row 3:** ch 4, [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 4] 12 times; ch 10, sk ch 4 sps, join with sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 4, turn = 13 sc, 13 ch-4 sps and one ch-10 sp.

- Rep Rows 1-3 until desired length 24 more times. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

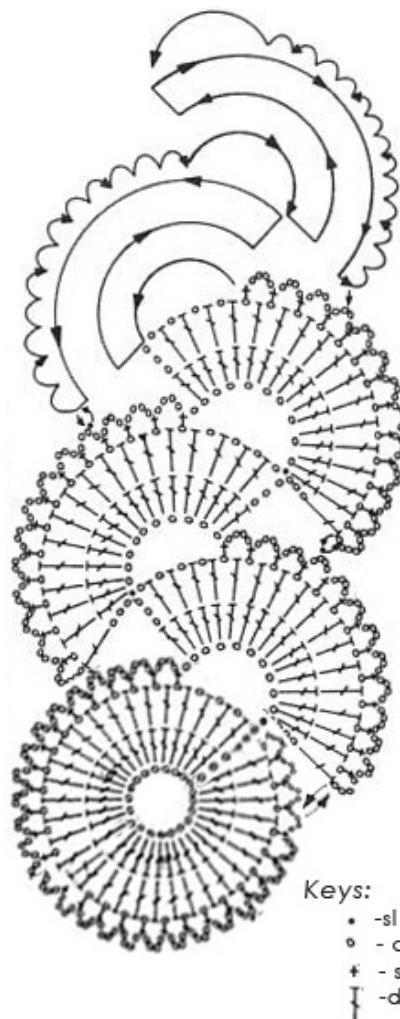
- With RS facing, join CA with sl st in any ch-4 sp, ch 4, [ch 3, sc] in each ch-4 sp around entire scarf; join with sl in 1<sup>st</sup> ch of beg ch 4. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
